"The WHO Country Cooperation Strategy (CCS) is a medium-term corporate strategic framework to guide WHO's work with Member States, taking into account national context and needs."

"The CCS is aligned with <u>WHO's General Programme of Work</u> (both GPW 13 and GPW 14), regional frameworks and flagship initiatives, while it also aims to accelerate the country's progress towards achieving the health-related Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). CCS priorities also provide major input to the development of the health component of the United Nations Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework or its equivalent, and can serve as an accelerator for the health agenda adopted by the UN Country Team."



Working group members and the organization supporting them commit to actively support the development and publication of the work for a tentative timeframe of 6 months or until completion.




Figure 1: The eight domains of building rapid response capacities and enabling systemic factors
